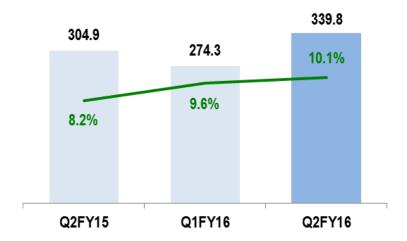
Financial Performance – Q2FY16

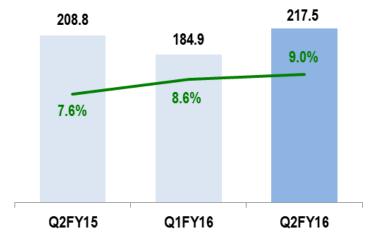


Net Revenues (Rs. Crores) and EBITDA margins (%)

Highlights of Q2FY16 performance

HIGHLIGHTS

- Q2FY16 Revenues at Rs 389 Crores; up 11% YoY, up 25% QoQ
- EBITDA up 37% YoY; 30% QoQ
- PAT at Rs. 8.9 Crores; up 52% YoY, up 45% QoQ
- EBITDA margins have improved by ~ 200 bps overall
- Continue to invest in expanding our existing businesses and in newer products

Net Revenues (Rs. Crores) and EBITDA margins (%)

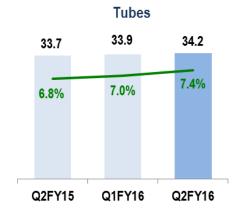

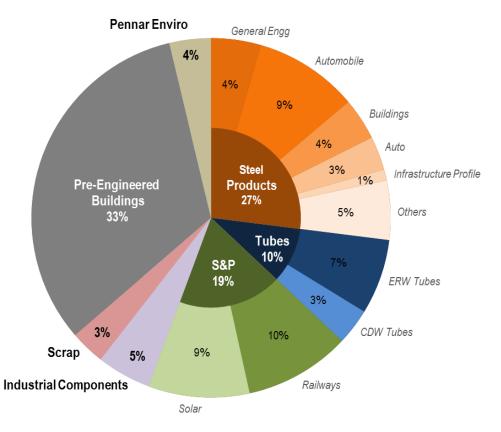
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Segment Composition

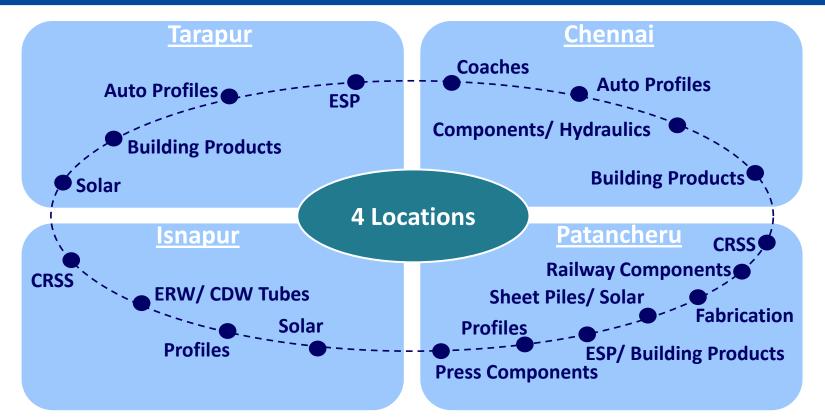
